- **Date of Availability**: Effective Thursday, June 11, 2020
- **Amounts**: Up to \$3,000 Per Cooperative Landlord / Tenant Stipulated Agreement
- **Total Funding**: \$7 million dollars from the [Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security \(CARES\) Act](#)
- **Eligibility**: Individuals / Families in Milwaukee County Facing Eviction or Behind on Rent due to a COVID-19 related loss of income. Recipients must be at 80% or less of the median income for the Milwaukee County metropolitan area.

The Milwaukee Rental Housing Resource Center (RHRC) formed in early 2020 as a collaborative effort to connect tenants and landlords to trusted resources that improve housing stability and prevent eviction. In anticipation of increased housing insecurity due to the COVID-19 public health pandemic, efforts to form the center have accelerated. The RHRC co-partners include the Apartment Owners Association of Southeast Wisconsin, City of Milwaukee, Community Advocates, IMPACT, Legal Action of Wisconsin, Legal Aid Society of Milwaukee, Mediate Milwaukee and Milwaukee County; project support is being provided by the Urban Economic Development Association of Wisconsin (UEDA).
