**Then our Back2Work Program is for YOU!**



### **What is it?**

Back2Work is a St. Vincent de Paul Society of Milwaukee program designed to help people get job ready, trained for a skilled trade profession and find a job.

We want our participants to succeed in their jobs and in their lives. As a part of that desire, we are committed to assisting our participants by providing trained volunteers as mentors in coming alongside each of them to meet and talk with them on a weekly basis in offering them encouragement, friendship and support in the situations they face as they develop their lives and careers.

### **What am I committing to?**

1. Participants must enroll or already be enrolled in FSET (Food Share Employment and Training).
2. Participants must commit to obtaining safety and forklift certifications at Milwaukee Community Service Corps, which takes 1 week.
3. Participants are then assigned a mentor to assist throughout the process for at least one hour a week and will attend a forty hour paid Back2Work training.
4. Participants who complete the training are then offered a 12 week internship, FSET training or work project, or Temporary to Permanent job.
5. Unsubsidized employment is the ultimate goal after all the steps are completed.
