ST. VINCENT DE PAUL GIFT CERTIFICATE REDEMPTION Neighbor must be present with their picture ID. Check in with the customer service desk. You will be given a list of items/dollar amount that you may select. You must take all items with you at time of certificate redemption unless delivery has been arranged. Certificates must be redeemed within 60 days of issue. Certificates may be used at any of our 3 stores. WAYS TO GET DISCOUNTS AT THE SVDP RIFT STORES: Every week there is color tagged merchandise that is 50% off. In addition, there are always clothing items tagged at .99 per piece. From Monday through Thursday students, seniors and military receive 10% off their purchase with a valid ID. The next clinic is on August 13th.
