
Be Sure to Enter the Most Essential Data in ServWare

Our conferences continue to use the ServWare system to process requests for help from neighbors. In 2022, we used ServWare to process 5,319 requests.

ServWare provides support for a variety of functions, and conferences may decide not to use all these features. But it is very helpful if each conference adopts a process to ensure they are entering the "most essential" data into ServWare. This includes:

- the date of the visit
- the names of the visitors
- the types and values of the assistance
- the final status to indicate that activity is complete

A member should also do a regular review to ensure all requests have been successfully processed. The diagram below shows a possible process by which data could be entered into ServWare. We are also **always eager to help** conferences with their use of ServWare, for developing the annual report or other reasons! Cares Gift Certificate Process

Your feedback is requested

Before we can implement the new "Cares" program, we ask for your feedback by completing a brief, one-minute survey.

The Society's "Cares" forms are currently set up to include a few different categories of assistance, in which you would designate a dollar amount for each. For example: \$50 for clothing, \$200 for furniture, \$50 for household, etc.

We have received feedback that many conferences prefer to issue a gift certificate with broader language. For example: \$250 for clothing, household items, and furniture. Unfortunately, the forms cannot be set up to accommodate both of these options so we ask for your feedback on which option is preferred.
