HISTORY

The Ladies of Charity was established in 1617 by St. Vincent de Paul and is the oldest religiously oriented lay volunteer group in existence. This international association of over 200,000 women in more than 50 countries serves in many ways to support those in poverty.

The primary mission of the Milwaukee chapter, founded in 1957, has been to provide clothing to children in need in primary through high school grades.

- Are inspired by the life of St. Vincent de Paul and come together to help meet the needs of the poor.
- Include homemakers, businesswomen, teachers, professionals and retirees.
- Gather used clothing through donations, clothing drives, and thrift stores and purchase items as needed. Teams work to staff the Clothing Center, sorting and organizing clothing, and meeting with families to select items.

Families in need are referred by their school social workers and bring vouchers to the Clothing Center. Every effort is made to provide each child with a wardrobe of new and gently used clothing that includes pants, tops, sweaters/sweatshirts, winter jacket, gloves, scarf, hat, underwear and socks.

We depend on the generosity of our members and the community to pay our rent, utilities and purchased clothing. All our 100 plus members are non-paid volunteers. We have been blessed to serve over 1,100 Milwaukee children annually. And the need keeps growing!
